If you are taking at least 6 total credits this summer (i.e. Seminar by the Sea + an additional course during Eastern University's Summer II semester), then you may be eligible for a Federal Stafford Loan. If you are only taking Seminar by the Sea, you may be eligible for Private Alternative Loans from Sallie Mae or Wells Fargo.
